REMINDERS:

- ◆ *Parents* - You have one vacation week of no Pay. Please let me know your vacation plans early.

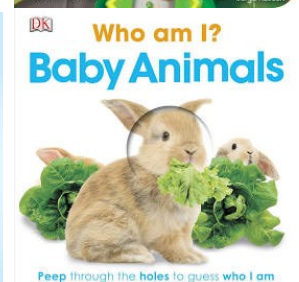
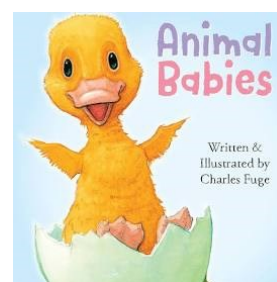
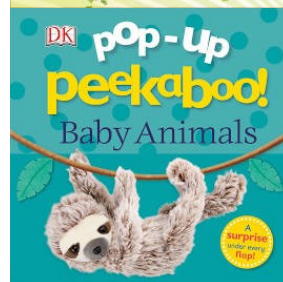
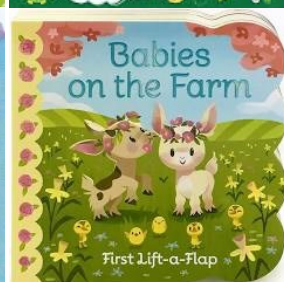
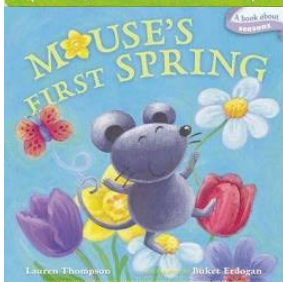
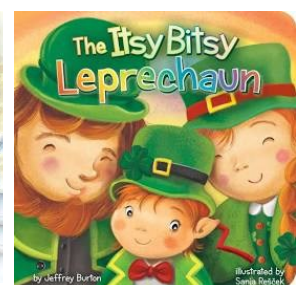
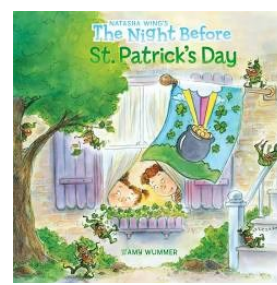
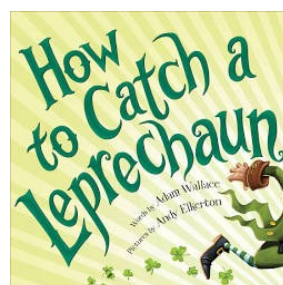
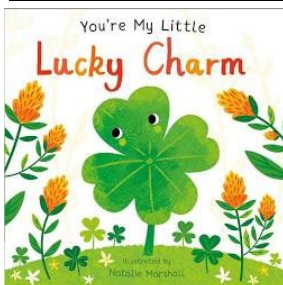
**ADDITIONAL REMINDERS**
