#### **Weather ALERT**

- ♦ KEEP AN EYE ON THE WEATHER Make sure your Child or Children have appropriate clothing CLOTHES:
- ♦ UPDATE CLOTHES IN CUBBIES -pants and long sleeve shirts in cubbies SICK POLICY:
- ♦ ITS FLU and STREP SEASON APPROACHING BESIDES THE COVID
- Be aware that Strep, Flu and COVID-19 have many symptoms like the other please use caution when assessing the health of your child this fall season, as we will be extra precautious about symptoms.
- ◆ Temperatures of 100 degrees or higher are to be sent home per licensing and your Child <u>must</u> be FEVER FREE for 24 hours!
